## Pryce: written by Nicole, Pryce's mother

Pryce is a wonderful vibrant almost 4 year old boy. Pryce experienced a semi traumatic birth after laboring all day to discover he was breach and required an emergency C-section. After a few months of seemingly normal development, Pryce began to miss common milestones like sitting up and reaching for toys. Pryce underwent several series of tests and MRI's and was diagnosed with partial Agenesis of the Corpus Callosum. The Corpus Callosum is a large nerve connection between our right and left brains hemispheres and Pryce's was only partially developed. This makes Pryce's world difficult to make sense of. What a typical child learns in a few weeks may take Pryce months to years. Sight, speech, balance and overall body control requires both sides of our brains to master and we have to teach Pryce's brain to make these connections. This means that Pryce cannot speak, crawl, roll over, stand or sit up independently, and cannot feed himself on a regular basis. However, Pryce has always had wonderful hearing and loves music, laughter, riding horses, attending basketball games and being in the swimming pool.

For the past 5 months, Pryce has been a part of CFCE program and over that time has made significant gains towards independence. Pryce showed a strong determination to walk after the



very first class! He is now sitting up with little help, using his arms and legs with more coordination and focus, and it is obvious he is getting stronger every day. He works so hard, but the pride in his face when accomplishing something is priceless! We have literally searched the globe for different methods of therapy and Pryce has experienced most of them at some point with less success than what we have found with Conductive Education. We could not be more excited about the upcoming summer camp and what new milestones Pryce will achieve. Our new motto we live by is Impossible is Nothing.

Pryce wants to run through the sprinklers and ride his bike without help, he doesn't need to tell us that, we can see it in his eyes! We believe this program will help him achieve his goals. Pryce is a very busy kid that can still throw a tantrum when dessert is taken away, but his progression since beginning the CFCE program has been an inspiration to us all and this couldn't be possible without the support of everyone, (sponsors, golfers, volunteers) and of course Jen!



## Hudson: written by Robin, Hudson's mother

Hudson is a happy, sensitive, caring, kind and shy II year old with a sharp wit. He was diagnosed with spastic diplegia at 20 months of age. In those early years, he received speech, occupational therapy, physical therapy and hippo therapy. Since age 4, Hudson started with a reverse walker, moved to forearm crutches and a manual wheel chair and now uses walking canes and a wheel chair to move about.

For the past 5 years, Hudson has received physical therapy weekly with CFCE, Ms. Jen, where he uses a wheel chair and walks short distances with walking canes. In the past and due to your support, he has attended CFCE summer camps and loves participating in the winter ski program. He has improved his skiing skills and enjoys the freedom on the slopes. His ski instructors feel he should be able to advance a new level next season. We are so appreciative for your support to this program.

Hudson works hard every week for Ms. Jen. We both feel that he maintains and keeps his strength due to her efforts. Ms. Jen is an amazing and incredible therapist and

resource. She goes above and beyond what I have seen with other organizations. She provides information and resources about possible interventions to help with foot pain and strengthening. She knows how to encourage Hudson to work hard while most of the time he feels like he is having fun. She accommodates our not-so-good days and continues to push him to grow and be strong giving him the confidence he needs to grow. While only a compliment a dedicated therapist can appreciate, Hudson will state, "I get angry with her because she makes me do so much!" When asked do you like Ms. Jen otherwise and does she help you, the response is always, "Yes". Thank you Ms. Jen!

Hudson enjoys hand cycling, wheelchair rugby, kayaking, sled hockey and of course video games. We wouldn't be where we are without CFCE. We greatly appreciate your support of their programs! Thank you from the bottom of our heart!
